

Sunday Reflection

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Christ. He gives Himself to us, not as a symbol, not just as a remembrance, but His actual Body to eat and His blood to drink, as nourishment, as food for our journey through life and beyond, into Eternity. At every Mass, a miracle happens, where Christ appears, just as He appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection, and at the Transfiguration. Every time we receive the Eucharist, Christ comes into us, in His Resurrected Body. It is with the eyes of faith that we see Him. It is with our heart that we take Him in, that He sustains us in our daily lives, in our relationships, in our joys and sorrows. And He comes to us through each other. Christ's great wish for us is Oneness. And in sharing in the Eucharist, we become the Body of Christ. We are not alone. We have each other, bonded in the greatest love in Heaven and on earth, to support, encourage, inspire and serve one another. This feast reminds us of Christ actually in our midst, in all His Goodness and Love, and gives us the joy of belonging to Him and to each other as we make our way back to God, and together, change our part of the world.
