Letter From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

I write this article on January 14th, the day our new archbishop Jeffrey Grob will be installed at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. Please keep him in prayer as he assumes leadership of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee! Fr. Ed and I will be attending, with representatives of our different parishes. I got to meet His Excellency last night after a vespers service at the cathedral. Archbishop ListECKI presided, but first archbishop-designate Grob came and knocked on the doors of the cathedral with a hammer. Fr. Kitzke, the rector of the cathedral, opened the doors for him. He venerated a crucifix and then blessed us with holy water, spent some time in prayer before the most Blessed Sacrament, and then vespers started. I am not sure if "sad" is the right way to describe the feeling, but there was certainly some kind of feeling of completeness inside as the "era" of archbishop ListECKI ended. Unless he has something on his schedule this morning that I am unaware of, that was the last liturgy that archbishop ListECKI presided over and at which he preached during his time as the leader of our archdiocese. His homily exhorted and encouraged archbishop-designate Grob as he now takes the crosier and begins to govern this archdiocese that has been entrusted to his care. I am grateful for all the good archbishop ListECKI has done during these past 15 years. He truly strives to be a man of the Church. I look forward in hope to this next chapter that begins today. May our Lord guide us in holiness and preserve us in the truth!

Our next joint pastoral council meeting is scheduled for January 28th at 6pm in St. Andrew Hall. Also, please recall the 6:30pm meeting at St. Mary in Lomira (the school cafeteria) about the status and future of our three religious education programs. Any interested parishioner is welcome to attend that meeting.
