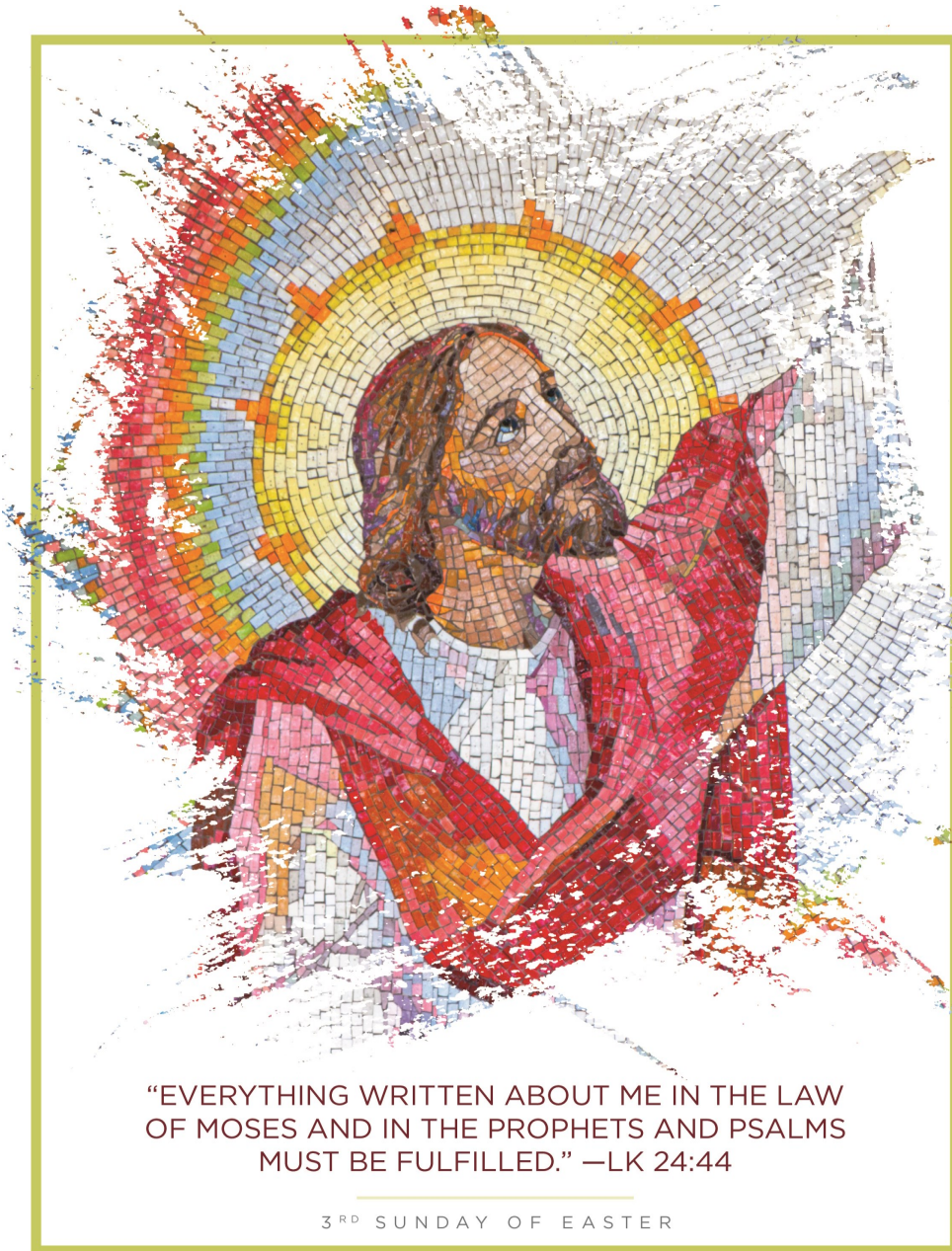

Sunday Reflection

The Risen Christ came to His disciples, His followers, those who believed in Him. They were trying to understand the meaning of the Resurrection. They were lost without Him.
