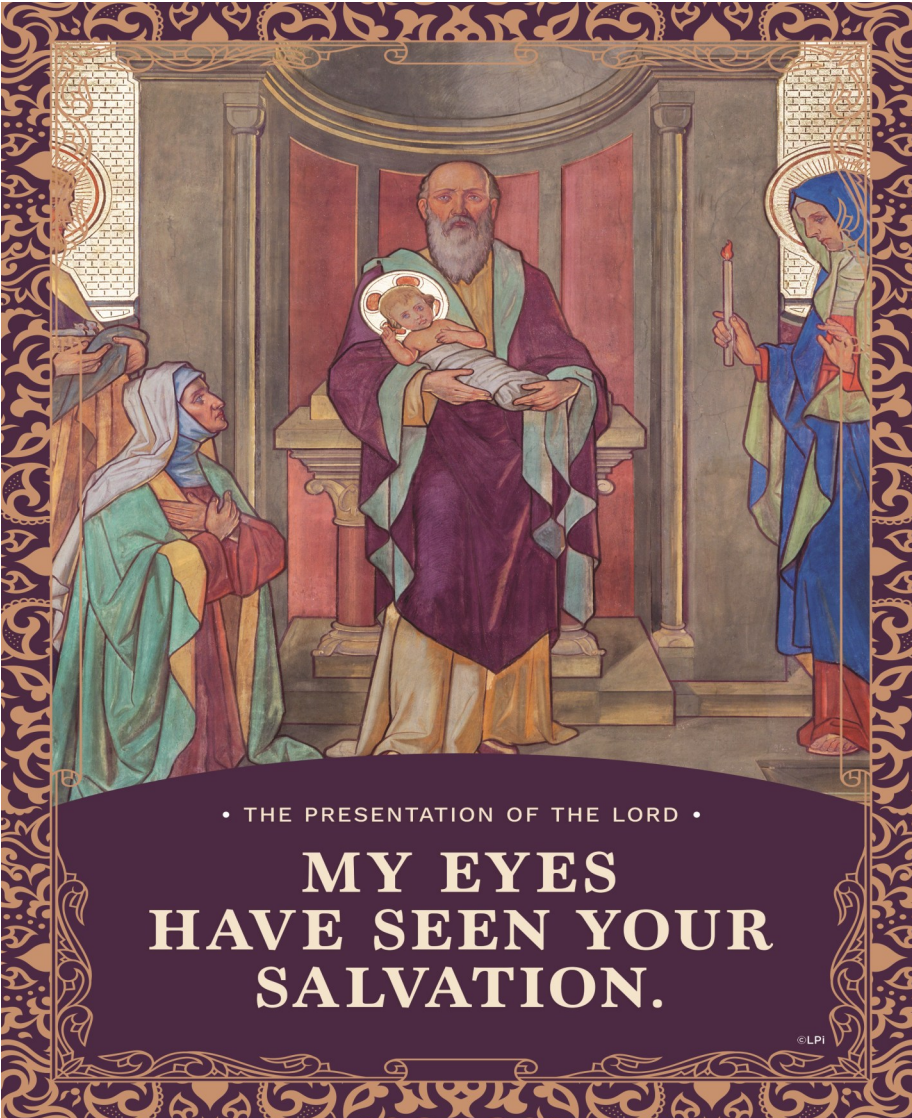

Letter From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

It was moving to participate in the Mass of Installation of the Most Rev. Jeffrey Grob as the archbishop of Milwaukee. The love for archbishop ListECKI was palpable and there was a sad, or in any case, moving moment as his time leading the archdiocese officially ended. I am not sure if I should describe it as sad... sad for him, for sure, I would think, though I am not 100% sure the source of the emotion he obviously felt. He would have to tell us what was going through his mind and heart. For me there was a certain sadness, almost like a death, as archbishop ListECKI is no longer my ecclesiastical father in the same way that he once was, and had been during the whole time I have been a priest. I keep vacillating between describing the feeling as "sadness" versus the more-encompassing "emotion." My apologies for subjecting you to my vacillations! :) In any case, I would like to emphasize that the main feature of what I feel is great hope, and for that I am very thankful to God! I have great, great hope for change for the better under the leadership of archbishop Grob. So much progress has been made in the archdiocese during the time of archbishop ListECKI, but of course we must ascribe the glory to God. We have cooperated with Him (at least to an extent!), yes, but He is the main Actor and has blessed us abundantly. Now we continue to pray for our new archbishop and implore our Lord to bless us time and time again, that we might bear much fruit for God's kingdom in this little part of the vineyard.

Now, for an abrupt transition. :) Please be aware that there are many scams via email and text messaging out there. People are constantly posing as me, for example, and asking people to give them money or whatever. Please realize that I am not the one reaching out to you like that! It is not that anything has been hacked (that I know of!), so I don't know any way to stop it. If you look closely, for example, you will see that the email sending these messages is not actually my email, even if it does have my name on it. Anyway, please be aware of what happens these days and do not fall for these traps! It is sad that there is so much con artistry out there.
