Every April, Catholic parishes and schools across the United States participate in National Child Abuse Prevention Month. Those in the dioceses work year-round to prevent abuse, but there is an emphasis on the importance of learning how to protect the vulnerable. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops created a program for the safe environment education of children and young people. The program Circle of Grace, was taught to students the last few years. During the Month of April, our religious education students will be taught another Circle of Grace lesson (based on grade level) by their Catechist and/or myself. Information regarding this program was sent via email to parents/guardians in the month of March. In honor of National Child Abuse Prevention Month, there will be various information, prayers and a Novena within the bulletin. We look forward to our Parish Community supporting us as we pray, and learn about protecting our most vulnerable; children and young people.
