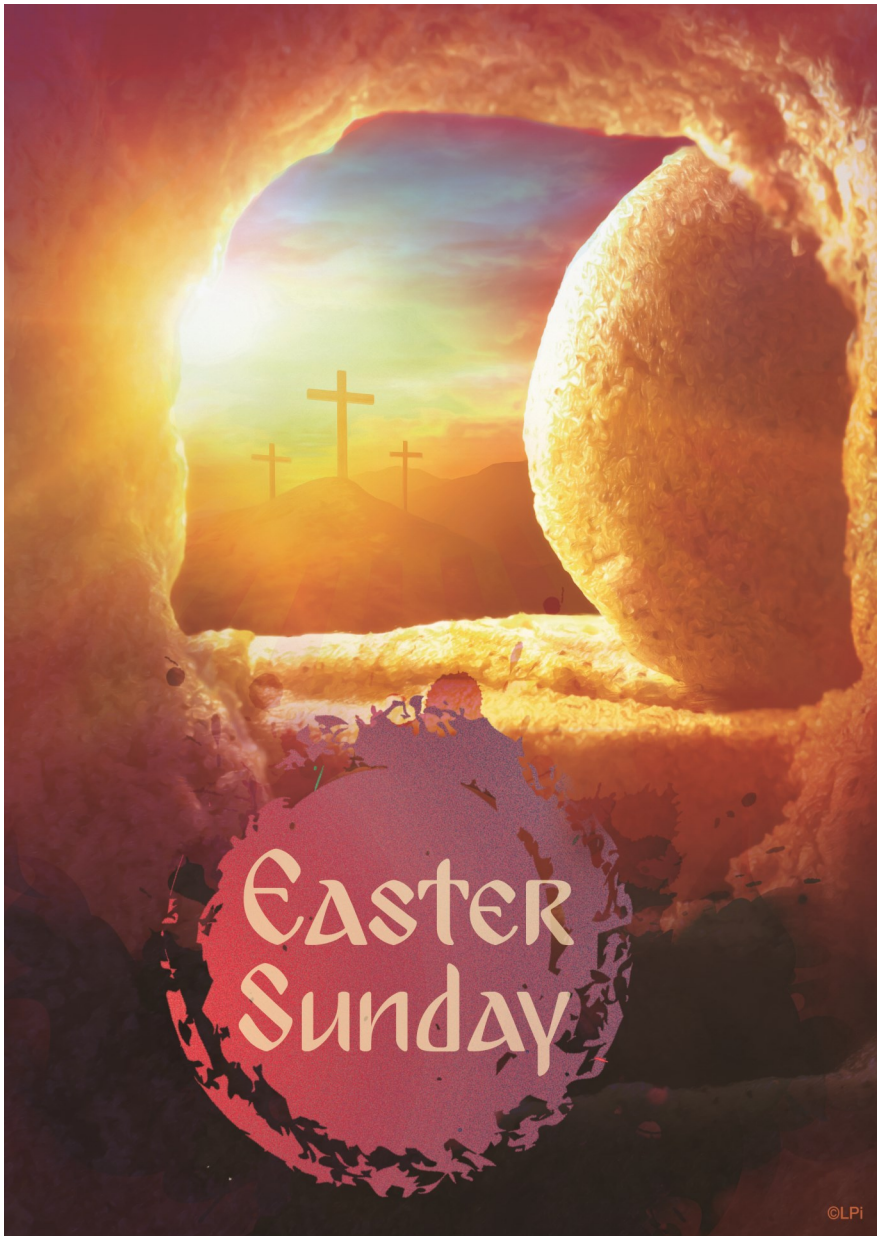

In honor of National Child Abuse Prevention Month, there will be various information, prayers and a Novena within the bulletin. We look forward to our Parish Community supporting us as we pray, and learn about protecting our most vulnerable; children and young people.
