The First <u>Did You Know</u> Article for St Theresa Church History.....

Did you know--

In 1849, the people of the village of Theresa decided that there was a need for the formation of a Catholic Parish in their community. Bishop Martin Henni purchased three lots in the village from Solomon Juneau and his wife Josette on April 23, 1849, for the sum of \$500.00. The deed said "for St. James Parish", but the first pastor, Rev. Frances Xavier Schraudenbach, who organized the parish, gave it the name St. Theresa. The first services were held in homes of various members and also in the basement of the former Rock River Hotel. Father Schraudenbach's successor, Reverend Beiter, built the first church, a log frame chapel in about 1851.
