



Article From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ, Blessed Easter!

Today is one of those Sundays with nicknames (quite a few of them in this case!). One of those is the Sunday of Divine Mercy. St. Faustina received private revelations from our Lord Jesus, deemed by the Church as worthy of belief, in which He asked that this Sunday be observed in special honor of His Divine Mercy. Pope John Paul II added "or of Divine Mercy" to the title of this Sunday in the Roman Missal. Anyway, we recently hung two new paintings in St. John church in Byron: one depicts St. James the Pilgrim, and the other the Divine Mercy! If you have not yet checked them out, this would be a good Sunday to stop in and pray. The 8am Mass will be at St. James church as usual as this is the fourth Sunday of the month. St. John church will be open, however, and people can stop in after attending Holy Mass elsewhere.

These are original paintings, beautifully done! We still have some cost from the framing to recoup (about \$300-\$400 I think). Would you like to help with that? :) My thanks go out to those who have already contributed in different ways to this project! Way back in 2020, a parishioner wanted to donate an image of the Divine Mercy. It turned out that a number of parishioners wanted to do so. However, it seemed to me that we could not do just one image. There would need to be balance. So, I took a look at images of St. James, since he is the other patron of Sons of Zededee parish, and there was no image of him in St. John church. Prints of the Divine Mercy abound, but images of St. James the Pilgrim are hard to come by! I thought about commissioning one... I did have a conversation at one point with an artist, but it did not go anywhere in the end. However, upon seeing the work of the artist who did end up doing the paintings, I knew this was someone we could commission. Approximately one year later, here we are with them framed and hung to nourish our prayer and beautify our church. At some point, we want to make prints of these available for sale. You may want these to hang in your home!:)

The next Young Adult night will start at 6:30pm on May 16th at St. Mary church in Lomira. We have a holy hour first, then the supper and social. Let's share some Easter joy together!

First Holy Communions are taking place this weekend and next, and our youth confirmation will be soon as well (May 14th at Sacred Heart in Horicon at 7pm). Please keep all of our young people who are receiving sacraments in your prayers!

The Easter Breakfast at St. Mary in Lomira is coming up on May 4th!
