

Article From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Blessed Palm Sunday! We are in the midst of "passion tide," the last two weeks before Easter. Some of our churches preserve the custom of veiling crosses and sacred images in purple during this time. This custom is retained in general as an option in the United States, so it may also be (re)-introduced in parishes where it fell by the wayside. It might seem funny to cover up the crucifix right in this time of year, but the idea is that as these sacred images are hidden from our sight we participate in a sort of liturgical dying with Christ. In addition, traditionally the Gospel on the 5th Sunday of Lent was Jn 8:40-59, which concludes with the line: "Jesus hid Himself, and left the temple." So, from that Sunday on, our Lord is hidden. He will be displayed upon His Cross (cf. Galatians 3:1) once again during the Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday. May we gaze then upon the loving, suffering Pierced One with all our love, sorrow for sin, adoration and gratitude!

Please see this bulletin for our Dodge East liturgical schedule for the Triduum.

The next Young Adult night will start at 6:30pm on April 25th at St. Andrew church (and supper to follow in the hall) in LeRoy.

Liturgical things to be aware of: Tuesday and Wednesday (the 15th and 16th) I plan to be around but also "lay low." The Chrism Mass in Milwaukee will be on Tuesday evening and I plan to concelebrate. A version of Tenebrae will be happening at Holy Trinity in Kewaskum on Wednesday evening (see their bulletin for the time, I would imagine). Tuesday and Wednesday the 15th and 16th we will not have our regularly scheduled Masses at St. John and St. James churches. All the other Masses on April 14th through the 16th in our Dodge East parish collaboration are scheduled as normal. After Easter, all 3 of us priests will take a little vacation time. There will not be the usual 5:30pm Mass at Sacred Heart on Monday the 21st. Tuesday the 22nd, there will only be the 8am Mass at St. Andrew, and no Mass at St. John. The rest of Easter week will flow according to usual liturgical patterns.:)

I know this is a ways away, but while I am thinking about it, please be aware that May 5th through the 7th all of our Dodge East daily Masses are canceled. All three of us priests will be at the Spring Assembly of Priests over those days. Thank you for understanding!

In closing, I wish we could all be together for the Triduum, but it is not to be this year (probably not next year either, lol, or the year after that, or the year after that... who knows when?). :) I am sure many of us long for all of our children to be together for big days like Easter. The pastor's father's heart has the same desire. I do want to thank everyone who will volunteer to help in so many ways over Holy Week to pull everything together. It is a lot of work and it does not go unnoticed or unappreciated. I believe that the joint Worship Committee did a good job of identifying when and where and how many of the different liturgies to offer. We will be well-served. :) Maybe someday we can all be together for just one of each. But in the meantime, we are united in Christ in the Holy Eucharist! He is the One upon Whom we focus. He is the One around Whom we must unite. Have a blessed Holy Week and a glorious celebration of Easter! Yours in Christ the Savior.
