Dear Friends in Christ,

February 22nd is the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, a good day to offer extra prayers for Pope Francis. I am not sure if you heard, but recently he was hospitalized with bronchitis. I am sure he appreciates prayer!

On February 23rd is the Oakfield Fire Department breakfast! It is right across the street from the church, so with 8am Mass there it is very convenient. Have a nice breakfast after Mass and support the fire fighters!

Please note that all of our parish offices will be closed the morning of February 28th to allow our parish staff to gather for prayer, a meeting and lunch together.

Also, on Friday the 28th, we have the second of the fundraising Fish Fries at Sacred Heart in Horicon! It is drive through only. The time runs from 4pm to 6:30pm. \$14 is the price. Head on over to support the parish and have some good food! :)

Ash Wednesday will be here soon: March 5th! We worked out the schedule at the joint Worship Committee meeting. Masses will be at 8am at St. Mary Mayville (the school kids will be joining), 8am at St. Theresa, 6pm at St. Andrew (Religious Ed kids joining), 7pm at Sacred Heart (Religious Ed kids joining), and 7pm at St. Mary Lomira.
