## Sunday Reflection

Today we see Jesus, with compassion, healing the leper. What is the purpose of our sickness and suffering? Only God knows the full answer to that. But we can find purpose if we surrender to Him in our suffering. What we do know, through knowing Jesus, is that He is with us in our suffering, so wanting to redeem us, to transform us, to heal us. It is in our deepest pain that He wants to bring us closest to Him. Right there is a profound purpose of our suffering. At Lourdes, much of the healing that takes place is spiritual healing. People take the step toward believing in Jesus, as the leper did. Just that step, that encounter and they are changed. And their lives are changed. "If You wish, You can heal me."
And Jesus says, "I do will it."
