

### **Sunday Reflection**

Today we hear the beautiful parable of the prodigal son. It is also the story of his brother, each in need of forgiveness and healing, both hold in their hearts the sin of preoccupation with self. Dear Friends in Christ,

We are pretty much in the middle of Lent, but Holy Week will be here before we know it! There will be two complete Triduum liturgies in our parish collaboration: one at St. Andrew in LeRoy and one at Sacred Heart in Horicon. No offense to any other of our parishes where there will be none (aside from Easter Sunday itself), or some, or all of the Triduum liturgies, :) but St. Andrew is **our** "cathedral" and will be our main site. This will include the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation if there are any to celebrate at the Easter Vigil. I will be present as pastor for Holy Thursday (helping with the music, Fr. Ed will celebrate the 7pm Mass of the Lord's Supper), Good Friday at 12:30pm (as celebrant) and the Easter Vigil at 8pm (as celebrant) at St. Andrew.


