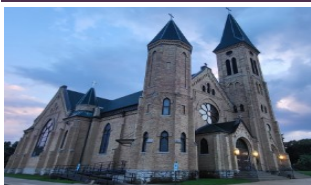

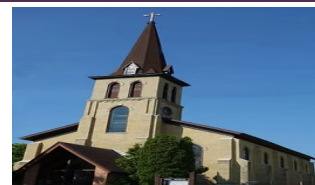

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last weekend we were blessed to celebrate the Presentation of the Lord/the Purification of the Blessed Mother/Candlemas! :) Feasts of the Lord outrank the Sundays in Ordinary Time. This feast is the final “echo” of the Christmas cycle. Please allow me to share here a general “thank you” to all who sent cards and Christmas gifts. Your kindness and prayers are much appreciated! Even though it is still a month away, our thoughts will begin to turn towards Lent soon enough, especially with the traditional pre-Lent season of Septuagesima that will begin next week. It is not too early to start praying about what practices of spiritual discipline our Lord is inviting us to embrace during the Lenten season. :)
