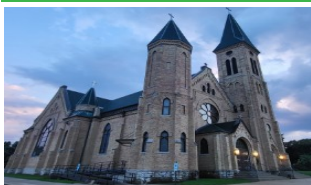

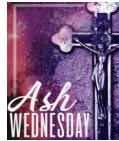

## Article From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Ash Wednesday will be here soon: March 5<sup>th</sup>! Masses will be at 8am at St. Mary Mayville (the school kids will be joining), 8am at St. Theresa, 6pm at St. Andrew (Religious Ed kids joining), 7pm at Sacred Heart (Religious Ed kids joining), and 7pm at St. Mary Lomira. There will also be a noon Word and Ashes service at St. James in Oakfield. Please note that other Masses that would usually happen on a Wednesday in our parish collaboration are canceled.

Here is a quick reminder about fasting and abstinence: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all Catholics (technically, those aged 18 to 59 inclusive) are obliged to fast. That means having at maximum only one full meal, and two smaller meals that do not add up to a full meal if needed to maintain strength. People who are sick, have special considerations like pregnancy, etc. should take account of those things and make reasonable accommodation as necessary without taking our obligation to fast lightly. In addition, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday of course, all Catholics are to abstain from meat (technically, from one's 14<sup>th</sup> birthday). It is good to note that all the Fridays of the year, except those Fridays on which a liturgical Solemnity falls, are days of penance: abstinence or another penance of our choosing. In Lent, however, abstinence in the USA is mandatory. These penitential practices differ in different countries/bishops' conferences around the world.

A couple of good parish social events are coming up! There will be a St. Patrick's Potluck at 4pm on Sunday March 16<sup>th</sup> in the school cafeteria at St. Mary in Lomira. We will have live music too! This was a great hit last year. On March 18<sup>th</sup>, we will have a parish collaboration/cluster-wide Stations of the Cross and soup supper over at St. Andrew. 6pm is the start time for Stations, with supper to follow in the hall. Please please mark your calendars and come! It will be a great opportunity to be together in Lent and pray on the eve of the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary. Wouldn't it be nice to see St. Andrew packed with people from all our parishes? :)

The next Young Adult night will be on March 21<sup>st</sup> at St. Mary in Lomira starting at 6:30pm! The one in April will be on **April 25<sup>th</sup>** (note that it is the fourth Friday since the third Friday is Good Friday and the location is TBD).

The next joint Pastoral Council meeting will be on April 8<sup>th</sup> at 6pm in St. Andrew Hall. We rearranged Pastoral Council and Finance Council dates to facilitate getting more recent reports to the Finance Council members.

Have a blessed start to holy Lent!

Dear Dodge East Friends and Family,  
There has been much discussion about the need to offer Catholic education for our children through middle school. At this time, we cannot offer our families a choice to continue with a Catholic education for their children past 4<sup>th</sup> grade. St. Mary Mayville is not big enough to house a middle school nor is it affordable to add on to the existing building. With the new parish collaboration of the Dodge East territory, two possible locations for a middle school were added to the discussions; St. Mary Lomira and Sacred Heart Horicon.

We would like to invite the Dodge East community to a meeting to discuss this plan and to get your input regarding your thoughts and opinions. The meeting will be held Thursday, March 6 at 6:00pm at Sacred Heart.

Agenda items:

- \*The need to offer our communities a choice for Catholic education through middle school
- \*At its current state, St. Mary Mayville is not large enough to house a middle school
- \*The need to establish an offsite satellite school
- \*Transportation; bussing from St Mary Mayville to satellite school and satellite school to St. Mary Mayville
- \*Is there an interest in bussing elementary age students to St. Mary Mayville from satellite school?
- \*Looking for community input from all who are interested
- \*Pros and cons of Lomira versus Horicon site
- \*Funding options and viability
- \*Community support of this project; questions, comments, and concerns

This is an opportunity for our community members to voice their opinions, ask questions, and discuss the possibility of a Catholic middle school. Please invite anyone who has interest in hearing more about this to the upcoming meeting.
