Sunday Reflection

Each time Jesus appeared after His Resurrection, they did not recognize Him. But then, through His actions, they did. Mary Magdalene, until He called her name. The Apostles in the upper room, until He ate, showing He was real. On the road to Emmaus, until He broke the bread of the Eucharist. And now on the beach when they see the miracle of the fish they caught because they listened to His command. The common thing in all of them, was their deep love of Him and yearning to be with Him. But they were in despair. It's our skepticism, our being stuck in our practical, material ideas of things, our seeing more on the human plane than on the Divine, that keeps us from recognizing Him in all the ways He comes to us. And He asks, "Do you love Me?" How deep is my response? How much do I really believe and trust in Him who is in our midst? Look for Him acting in your life.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Blessed Easter!

We continue to rejoice in the Resurrection, as well as the celebrations of First Holy Communion! Please continue to keep all of our first communicants and their families in your prayers. Our youth confirmation quickly approaches also: May 14th at 7pm at Sacred Heart in Horicon. All are welcome to join in prayer at that Mass, and please keep our *confirmandi* in prayer as well.

It was a joy to announce last weekend that Fr. Zachary Galante has been appointed by Archbishop Grob to be our new parochial vicar, taking the biretta from Fr. Ed as he becomes a senior priest. :) Fr. Galante will have been a priest for one year when he arrives, starting in mid-July (I already have Fr. Ed lined up to keep helping us until Fr. Galante gets here!). I asked Father how he would like to be addressed and he will go by Fr. Galante. It will be nice no longer to be the youngest priest on the team, haha. Fr. Galante will be a wonderful addition to our Dodge East community and a great help to me. He hails from West Bend, and I am pretty sure this will be the most rural setting he has lived in to date. Perhaps he can write an article to introduce himself before he arrives. He is finishing up studies in Rome (hence the later than usual arrival in his assignment here), and is even there for a papal conclave! I was there for the last conclave so it is kind of wild that we will share that experience.

Speaking of conclaves, this is the first opportunity I have to mention here the passing of the Holy Father, Pope Francis, which I am sure by now everyone has heard. We certainly want to lift up his soul, as we do all the faithful departed, asking our merciful Lord that Pope Francis be granted eternal rest in Christ. I offered a Holy Mass for the repose of his soul last Monday. It is also very important that we keep the cardinals in prayer who have the responsibility to elect the next pope. May they truly be docile to the promptings of the Holy Spirit!
