

Sunday Reflection

Today we are brought into Holy Week, the most Sacred time of the Church, the culmination of Jesus's time on earth, the week that changed the possibilities of the world. It is the fulfillment of His mission in bringing us into union with God, and not leaving us alone here, but staying with us in the Most Holy Eucharist. Let us prepare this week, by entering into the awesome mysteries of our God, who loves us more than we can imagine;

by searching for all that this means in our lives, in our suffering, in our receiving the gift of being made new in the One who created us and brings us into Himself.

Dear Friends,

I invite you to participate in our Holy Week activities. Holy Week commemorates the last week of the life of Christ. The schedule is on the front of the bulletin for your reference. Holy Thursday celebrates the Institution of the Most Holy Eucharist and the Lord's model of service in the washing of the feet.

On Good Friday we hear the Passion story according to St. John, we venerate the Cross, and receive Communion consecrated the night of Holy Thursday.

The Easter Vigil begins Saturday night with the lighting of the new fire, the blessing of the Easter Candle, the blessing of the new Holy Water, and the renewal of our Baptismal promises. We also receive the first Eucharist of the Easter season. We also renew our Baptismal promises at each mass on Easter Sunday.

I am grateful for the assistance of the Fr. Al Van Beek, who will offer the 9:15am mass on Palm Sunday at St. Theresa and Fr, Neil Zinthefer, who will offer the 7:45am mass on Easter at St. Andrew.
