- Financial information The financial statements through 12/31/23 were reviewed.
- Tracy was going to check into what goes into the stole/stipend expense account. She also
  explained that the scholarship program applications are available in the parish office. The
  application form will be put on the website. Recipients are chosen by a committee made up of
  members from each parish.

## Pending or Completed Items since last meeting:

- 1. Completed –Greg H has caulked the parish hall gutter in front but the rear one still has water in it so will be done at a later date.
- 2. Completed: Both freezers were removed on December 2nd.
- 3. Pending Terry is coordinating the installation of the new sound system for church. Daniel is continuing to trouble shoot with Paul. Electrical work needs to be completed.
- 4. Pending The wall in the East vestibule is showing some bubbling. Debbie has contacted Kyle from Cornerstone Restoration. They did the initial repairs a few years ago and will review the situation.
- 5. Pending Concrete work update:
  - K&D quote of \$67,400 was approved by the committee. A proxy for the Archdiocese has been prepared and Tracy will present at the Pastoral Council meeting on February 27<sup>th</sup>. The proxy needs the signatures of St. Andrew's trustees, the Pastoral Council President and Fr. Ed. It will then be emailed to the Archdiocesan office for approval.
  - Greg will work with K&D on timing.
- 6. Completed the parking lot light at the end of the sidewalk directly in front of the rectory is working. The switch is located in the closet in the priest's sacristy.

#### **New Business:**

- 1. Debbie will purchase a cellular phone for the rectory with TracFone has the service provider. The phone has minimal use and the monthly cost was too high.
- 2. Rectory updates:
  - a. Bathrooms this will be the first project. Two of the four bathrooms' tubs/showers are unusable at this time due to crumbling tile.
  - b. Terry will purchase two lamps for the living room since the two currently there are fire hazards.
  - c. Per Fr. Ed's request, Tracy will purchase a rug for the hallway.
- 3. Completed The facility usage agreement has been updated and is available on the website.
- 4. Completed Dumpster renewal agreement was signed by the trustees.
- 5. Greg H will check into the light that is not working in the hall above the stainless steel sink.
- 6. Daniel is attending the Dodge County redistricting meetings as St. Andrew's representative. Fr. Justin (Horicon) will be reassigned in June so Fr. Miniatt (Lomira & Sons of Zebedee) and Fr. Ed will begin serving Sacred Heart Horicon along with their current parishes.
- 7. This year is St. Andrew's 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Terry and Tracy will look for volunteers to coordinate a celebration.

## **Five Year Plan:**

- 1. Concrete work front, East side , sidewalk on the south side of the church, steps from both the priest's sacristy and the server's side, look at ramp, concrete slab at the back.
- 2. Rectory updates flooring, furniture, window coverings, plumbing.
- 3. Electrical updates in church.
- 4. Ramp repairs—Greg H reported that we will need a separate company that specializes in ramps.
- 5. Church & parish hall signage
- 6. St. Mary school support

- ✓ Spring 2024 project: Landscape around the Sacred Heart statue.
